



SHOOTING A DEER ON SUNDAY PROVES COSTLY

A Tory Hill man has been fined \$1000 for illegal deer hunting.

David Nuttall, 43, was fined \$1,000 for hunting deer on Sunday in a non designated municipality.

Court was told that on Sunday, November 18, 2007, Nuttall shot and killed a mature white-tailed deer with a high powered rifle in Monmouth Township in the Municipality of Highlands East, where Sunday gun hunting was not permitted in 2007.

Minden area conservation officers investigated the offence and also seized the deer.

Hunters are reminded to check the current hunting regulations to see where Sunday hunting is allowed. The Hunting Regulations Summary 2008-2009 is available free of charge from licence issuers, ServiceOntario/Government Information Centres and on the ministry's website at ontario.ca/hunting.

Justice of the Peace Dianne Jackson heard the case in the Ontario Court of Justice in Lindsay on November 21, 2008.
